

Rural Territorial Development Approach



In our 35 years of research experience, we have arrived at five core principles and operational criteria of the rural territorial development approach that guide Rimisp's advocacy work in Latin America:

- Investment in the territory's assets
- Multisectoral approach
- Rural-urban linkages
- Effective participation and empowerment of territorial actors, towards the construction of a territorial institutionality
- Collective vision of the future

HOWEVER, THE GOVERNANCE NECESSARY TO ADOPT THESE CRITERIA IN PRACTICE WILL DEPEND ON THE REALITY OF EACH TERRITORY, PROJECT OR PROGRAM WITH WHICH ONE IS WORKING.




BEEKEEPING GOVERNANCE



"It is the development of <u>relationships between various actors</u> involved in the process of deciding, executing and evaluating matters of public interest, a process that can be characterized by <u>competition and cooperation</u> where they coexist as possible rules; and that includes both <u>formal and informal institutions</u>.". (CEPAL, 2021).


